- Take the VIRTUS training and get a background check before you work with children

- ➤ Always set a good example
- ➤ Address negative behaviors by kids

Friars Club Code of Conduct for Coaches

The goal of Friars Club is to develop valuable life skills in our youth through sports, education and leadership programming to enrich their lives and our community. The adherence to the Friars' values is a requirement of all parents and players participating in Friars Club events. Friars' values of **Respect**, **Responsibility**, **Leadership**, and **Good Sportsmanship** are emphasized in all aspects of the Friars Club program.

Friars Club accepts responsibility for the behavior of its members. Disciplinary action may be taken against any individual, parent, player, coach, referee or visitor who fails to comply with the values of this organization.

COACH'S CODE OF CONDUCT

- 1. I will arrive to the game no later than a half-hour prior to the game's start.
- 2. Sports and games belong to the players. I will place the emotional and physical well-being of the players ahead of my personal desire to win.
- 3. I will do my best to make this a FUN learning experience for every player.
- 4. I pledge to provide POSITIVE support, care and encouragement for all the athletes of the Friars Club by adhering to Friars' values. I will set a good example for the participants.
- 5. I will instill notions of fair play and good sportsmanship by demonstrating positive support for ALL players, parents and officials at every game, practice or other Friars Club related event.
- 6. I will applaud the good plays of both teams. I will NEVER engage in booing or taunting. I will ensure that my players don't engage in these behaviors.
- 7. I will never swear, use profanity, make obscene gestures, or engage in any inappropriate behavior or conduct at any time.
- 8. I will communicate respectfully and support the players in order to encourage a positive and enjoyable experience FOR ALL.
- 9. I WILL REFRAIN FROM NEGATIVELY YELLING AT THE PLAYERS during practices or games. If I yell at the players, I will follow it with positive encouragement at the next opportunity.
- 10. I will keep a HANDS-OFF POLICY. I will not pull, push, touch, or pick up any player.
- 11. I will make every attempt to have my players attend every game and practice on time. As a team leader, I must be fully committed to the team. I will communicate immediately when there is a reason for absence or lateness.
- 12. I will make sure that my players are dressed appropriately for both games and practice.
- 13. I will treat all players, officials, parents, and spectators with dignity and respect in language, attitude, behavior and mannerisms.
- 14. I will insist that my assistant coaches and players treats other players, coaches, spectators, parents and officials with respect in language, attitude and mannerisms.
- 15. I WILL LEAD BY EXAMPLE, BEING A POSITIVE ROLE MODEL AND SHOWING GOOD LEADERSHIP SKILLS.
- 16. I will not drive any player without permission. I must have a license and proof of insurance on file at Friars Club.
- 17. I will not organize any outside activities or fundraisers without Friars Club permission.
